Contest Rules

Contestant Rules

1. Age of Contest is open to 6 to 10 years old.
2. This is a program about Fire Prevention.
3. Contest will be interviewed by a panel of judges in the preliminaries and the same judges will officiate during the finals. The judges will not be members of the Hampstead Volunteer Fire Department or Ladies Auxiliary. The judges' decision is final.
4. Judges will include the following points system. The contestant with the highest number of points will be the winner

a. General Appearance 0 – 10 points

b. Poise and Personality & Speaking Ability 0 – 40 points

c. Fire Prevention Knowledge 0 -50 points

The Final judging will be completed onstage and will include the following:

Little Miss will be asked onstage "How will you spread the Fire prevention message?"

5. The preliminary portion of the contest will consist of a three to five minute interview by the panel of judges. The judges may ask any questions from the list of questions provided to both the contestants and judges. The judges may also ask questions relevant to the contestant's application.
6. The contestant will perform a 5 - 10 Minute Presentation to the Judges on any Fire Prevention Topic that they wish to perform. You are allowed to use PowerPoint, presentation boards and other means to present your project. This is a mandatory part of the presentation.

7. The final portion of the contest will be "on stage" and the contestants will compete in the order they interviewed in. All contestants will be asked questions drawn "fish bowl" style and will come from the list provided to the judges.

8. The Little Miss Fire Prevention is eligible to compete in the MCFA Contest in 2018 and is encouraged to attend and compete. If she cannot attend it is her responsibility to contact her 1st Runner-up.

9. Each contestant must adhere to proper dress codes. No jeans or shorts. Khakis, skirts, 'Sunday best' dresses are acceptable attire when representing HVFD as a Fire Prevention Ambassador.

10. Applications must be received no later than July 31, 2018

Little Miss Fire Prevention Questions 2018-2019

Little Miss

- Each contestant will present a drawing they have completed that shows a fire safety message that they think is important. Topics may include, but are not limited to: Don't Play with Matches; Stop, Drop, and Roll; Knowing what number to call in case of emergency; Firefighters are your friends; etc.
- These drawings will be presented to the judges in an individual interview where the young ladies will be asked to talk about their drawings and answer the question "Why do you want to be Little Miss Hampstead Fire Prevention?"
- For the onstage portion, the young ladies will pick one of the following fire prevention questions from random and asked to give their answer to it:
 - o What number should you call if your house catches on fire?
 - o What information should you have ready to give to the 911 operator?
 - o Why is important to practice safe ways out of your house before a fire occurs?
 - o What would you do if your clothes catch on fire?
 - o Why should all families have a meeting place? Where should it be?
 - o What should you do if you find matches sitting on a table or counter?
 - o What are some hot items in your house? Why shouldn't you touch them?
